Sky Warriors was formally registered as a club in September 2011.

BADMINTON

- Club started badminton in May 2014. There have been quite a few members playing badminton on regular basis since it started.
- Badminton is being played thrice a week for men- Tuesday, Thursday and Friday mornings.
- Numerous coaching sessions are held during the year.
- Since 2014 in its annual activities the club organizes
 - Sky Warriors Badminton Championship (SWBC) Singles and Doubles Event for men & women.
 - Sky Warriors Badminton Tournament (SWBT) Team tournament comprising Men's, Women's & Mixed Doubles.
 - Sky Warriors Badminton League (SWBL) Internal League of Sky Warriors players through out the year.

External Games

- Club participates in Annual Dayal Interclub and Dayal Open Badminton Tournament.
- Club also organizes inter club tournament with other clubs on periodic basis.

BADMINTON

- Badminton is being played five times a week for women Monday, Wednesday mornings and evenings and Saturday Mornings.
- For Kids Badminton coaching is provided at a subsidized rates on Saturday mornings by professional coaches.
- Men Women and Kids are encouraged to participate in external tournaments while representing the club.
- Club has also been lucky to have Ms. P.V. Sindhu (World No. 1 player as well as Silver Medalist in Olympics) from India to meet the members of the club as well as give inspiring messages to the badminton players of the club.
- In one week there are more then 150 members participating in Badminton.

CRICKET

- Cricket being subject of interest for majority of the members, is the prime sport of the Sky Warriors Club.
- Currently club provides regular net practice sessions to its members thrice a week.
- Club participates in three major tournaments during the year
 - HKCA Challenge League
 - KCC Morning social league organized by KCC
 - -PKVR morning social league organized by DLSW
 - Saturday League Shared team with Taipan Cricket Club
- Apart from these major tournaments, club organizes & takes part in other small tournaments organized by various clubs or organizations.
- Club also organizes Sky Warriors Championship once a year.
- There are regular practice matches at PKVR on Friday mornings.

CRICKET TRAINING

- Sky Warriors being one of the most disciplined club, gives utmost importance to the regularity, discipline and commitment. Following are the highlight of the net sessions which will be organized during the year.
- Net Sessions are being conducted by our coach Mr. Ankur Vasishta who is one of the ex national player of Hong Kong cricket team.
- Nets sessions are being arranged thrice a week:
 - Monday Morning 7 am 9 am
 - Thursday Night 8 pm 10 pm
 - Sunday Morning 8am 10am
- Members have been divided in two groups and alternate groups are being trained on Tuesday and Thursday. Whereas, both the groups are simultaneously trained on Sunday.
- Attendance register of the net sessions are being maintained on regular basis.

ELIGIBILITY TO PLAY CRICKET GAMES/TOURNAMENTS

- Eligibility of any member playing in any tournament will depend on their nets attendance.
- Members having attendance not less than 50% only will be eligible to play, irrespective of their cricketing caliber, in any of the tournaments arranged by various organizations.
- Any member having attendance not less than 20% only will be eligible to play, irrespective of their cricketing caliber, in any of the internal leagues organized by the club.
- Any person having attendance lesser than the criteria mentioned above, will only be eligible to play in tournaments if there are not enough players meeting the above net attendance criteria.
- If there are more members than required, who meets eligibility criteria, cricket selection committee will decide the best possible squad taking into consideration all the relevant factors.



YOUTH CRICKET

Club has taken initiative to train the youth of the community in their cricketing skills. All the children meeting following criteria will be eligible to apply for this program.

- Person of Indian Origin
- Hong Kong Resident
- Bellow the age of 14 years

So far,

- Club has participates in HKCA under 11 league.
- Club also participates in HKCA under 13 league from this year onwards jointly with KARP group. Club has also encourages young girls to play along. Due to this initiative Ms. Venezia Asuncion Ogden has already played 2 under 13 league game in this season from our team.













TENNIS

- Club started tennis in May 2014.
- Tennis is being played thrice a week Monday Wednesdays and Friday.
- Club also provides tennis coaching in the year from time to time at a subsidized rate to its members for individual improvement.
- Club has recently started tennis for women and will be providing coaching to aspiring Women Tennis enthusiasts.
- Since 2015 in its annual activities the club organizes
 - Sky Warriors Tennis Championship (SWTC) Singles and Doubles Format.
 - Sky Warriors Tennis Tournaments (SWTT) Team Format.
 - Sky Warriors Tennis League (SWTL) Internal League of Sky Warriors players through out the year, to be started in 2018.

External Games

Club participates in Annual tournament organized by UNITED LEGENDS.
